Notes: (1) 2nd and 3rd children from the same family receive a 5% discount on tuition.

(2) Includes the cost for student textbooks, workbooks, supplies, computer lab, and yearbook. Does not include the cost for student uniforms or optional field trips.

(3) If Tuition is paid monthly by choosing Option 3 below, a one-time service charge of 6% of tuition is due with the first payment on August 1st.

(4) Amount due if all tuition and fees are paid in full by August 1st in which Tuition Refund Plan Insurance is optional.

Deposit and Payment Options

There is a \$200 enrollment deposit that is non-refundable. This deposit will be credited toward the annual tuition amount.

Tuition and fees for the academic year will be paid in accordance with the terms of one of the following options:

ANNUAL – One payment in full. All tuition and books & supplies fees are paid by August 1st of the current year.

BIANNUAL – Two payments: 50% of tuition and 100% of books & supplies fee is paid by August 1st of the current year, and 50% of tuition is paid by January 1st of the next year. Required purchase of Tuition Refund Insurance equal to 3% of tuition and paid by August 1st.

MONTHLY – The first tuition payment (1/9 of tuition) and 100% of the books & supplies fee is paid by August 1st. The remaining eight monthly tuition payments are due on the first of each month thereafter. The final payment is due on April 1, 2013. A one-time service charge of 6% of tuition is due on August 1st.

Tuition Refund Insurance

Tuition Refund Insurance (TRP) is required of all Biannual and Monthly payment plans. It is optional for those choosing to pay tuition and books & supplies fees by August 1st. TRP is available to all families in order to protect their yearly financial obligation. This program insures fees (prepaid and due) in the event of separation from the school according to the terms of the policy. The TRP will pay benefits to the school and provide substantial assistance in meeting your financial obligation. Remaining benefits not required to meet your obligation to the school will be refunded to you by the school.
